Lareau releases new single "Don't Let Me Go" from forthcoming album

(New York, NY) Lareau is the band that has gained international attention due to its honest cool-mountain-stream anesthetic combining an Eagles/Byrds roots-reverence with a Fray/Maroon 5 modernity. Lareau—founding member and lead vocalist Larry Lareau, drummer/multi-instrumentalist Darrin Payne, guitarist Pete Gool, bassist Roger Christopherson and keyboardist Anthony Brown—is the five-piece band from Western New York and Pennsylvania whose music is a refreshing and uplifting acoustic/electric trip that has had record buyers swooning to its intricate musical interplay.
